ASET CEU Information

ASET Continuing Education Units (ASET-CEUs) are awarded to programs who apply to ASET for this designation and who maintain the highest quality of education for the profession. Attendees are then awarded ASET-CEUs for the number of hours in which they participate in a particular program.

ASET CEUs are recognized by ABRET and BRPT for recertification.

Approximately 5.75 ASET CEU's will be awarded for Friday, 5.75 credits for Saturday, and 6 credits for Sunday. The IOM educational workshop will be awarded 5.75 ASET CEU's and the EEG Board Prep will be awarded 11.75 credits for the full 2 days. You can earn close to 18 CEU's with a full 3 day registration.
