

## Transportation resources for travel between Seatac International Airport and Grand Hyatt Seattle

To travel from the airport to downtown Seattle the most cheaply, the light rail is the best. Check out the link: <https://www.soundtransit.org/schedule>

It works well if you have a manageable amount of luggage and you are in reasonably good shape to walk . The ride is around 38 min from the airport light rail station to Westlake Center at Pine and 5th and costs \$3.00. The hotel is at Pine and 7th, so it is only a 3 block jaunt from the train stop. The train comes every 6-15 minutes depending on what time of day you are travelling. See the link: <https://www.soundtransit.org/schedules/link-light-rail>
